What to do in the fall garden:

- 🕊 Plant daffodils, tulips, crocus, and other spring blooming bulbs. Narcissus are deer and rabbit resistant!
- Refresh sun-weary container gardens with fall favorites, such as kale, mums, and pansies. Need inspiration? Sign up for our free container planting demo.
